Fax, Email or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not valid. Express Mail entries must be clearly marked.
: **NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED.** No hand delivery of entries are accepted. **No emailed or photocopy of entry forms are accepted.**

AKC Chapter 1, Section 5: The Event Committee has the right to decline any entries or may remove any dog from its trial for cause, but in each such instance shall file good and sufficient reasons for doing so with AKC.

NO unentered dogs are allowed on the club premises during these trials per AKC rules.

We have limited crating space and ask that all exhibitors place your chairs in front of your crates. No lounge chairs or x-pens are allowed at these trials. When entering and exiting the building, all exhibitors must use the entrance by the fenced in exercise area to the RIGHT of the building.

Back Entrance/Parking: Only Event Committee Members and Trial Volunteers are permitted to use the back entrance door and back parking. Signs will be posted accordingly. There is plenty of parking in front and side of the building. These signs are to be adhered to both days of the trials. No Exceptions.

All exhibitors are required to pick up after your dog and if found not doing will be dealt with by the Event Committee accordingly.

There is no training use of any equipment during or after trial hours which begin when the doors open each day. No equipment may be taken outside to train or practice for any reason. Anyone doing so will be dealt with by the Event Committee. The agility field to the rear of the building is not to be used for any reason during these trials.

Walkways will be marked off by blue tape on the floors and only exhibitors with dogs getting ready to enter the ring are allowed past those blue lines. No dogs with handlers are allowed by the Steward Table. There is no blocking any walkways either standing or sitting as well as no one is to congregate by the ring at all. You will be asked to leave the area and those not abiding by these standards will be dealt with by the Event Committee.

Please remember that these trials are governed by the AKC as SOTC is a Licensed Club. We appreciate everyone who supports our trials and we pride ourselves on making our trials a fun place for all.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes; please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
4. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
